SYNCHRONOUS LEARNING

Instructor-Paced Courses

Synchronous learning enables students to avoid feelings of isolation.

- Schedule Quizzes and Test ahead of time.
- Schedule Video conferences and calls
- Live streamed lectures or demos



ASYNCHRONOUS LEARNING

Self-Paced Courses

Asynchronous learning enables students to follow the curriculum at their own pace without worry of schedule conflict.

- Pre-record lectures and demos
- Create Social Media groups
- Uploading collaborative documents in a cloud based subscription

THE FOUR LEARNING MODALITIES



VISUAL

- Use charts, graphs and illustration to make connections
- Incorporate fonts and typeface that sets tone and holds attention spans.
- Stream demonstrations via online videos
- Use visual note taking tools



AUDITORY

- Use music, theater and noises to engage students
- Encourage classroom participation and discussion boards.
- Play audio stories and encourage the use of audiobooks
- Verbal repetition of learning material



KINESTHETIC

- Contextualize the learning examples. Use modern day artifacts that connects with your learning material
- Present theatrical elements and sports as a way to express learning elements in a physical manner



TACTILE

- Role playing exercises
- Encourage the use of props and doodling.
- Use moving materials, build and manipulate objects
